# Purpose/Scope:

To ensure packaging integrity and eliminate damage to purchased components en route to Reiloy USA.

## **Procedure:**

## 1. RUST PREVENTION:

- All parts must be protected using a Non-Hazardous rust inhibitor (e.g.: paper, plastic, spray, dip) or a combination of these should be used to ensure parts are free of rust upon arrival at Reiloy USA

## 2. WOOD REQUIREMENTS:

 All wood used must adhere to ISPM 15 requirements when required or requested by Reiloy USA

#### FRONT END COMPONENTS-EXCLUDING SCREWS AND BARRELS:

- Any package under 50 lbs. can use a cardboard package reinforced as needed depending on component characteristics to prevent damage during shipping
  - All empty voids inside the package needs to be filled with crate paper, bubble wrap, or any other acceptable packaging material to eliminate movement of the components
- Multiple parts in the same package need to secured/protected in a manner to ensure parts do not sustain damage during shipping

- Any package over 50 lbs. requires a reinforced wood box designed to be move via fork truck
  - Minimum thickness/material accepted is 3/4" OSB
  - Parts need to braced with wood and screws inside the box to eliminate movement of the components
- All wood packaging must use screws to attach the lid to the package for ease of removal upon arrival at Reiloy USA
- Steel banding strips are required for all reinforced wood packaging
  - The number of strips used should be consistent with the size/weight of the package (Minimum of 2)

## 4. SCREWS, BARRELS AND ALL OTHER LARGE COMPONENTS:

- Any package under 150 lbs. requires the use of a REDDI-CRATE® with a .250" minimum wall thickness, or equivalent cardboard product that shares the same or better physical properties in strength and rigidity
  - Dimensional wood is acceptable if REDDI-CRATE® or equivalent is unavailable. In this case guidelines for packages over 150lbs must be followed
  - All empty voids inside packages needs to be filled with crate paper, bubble wrap, or any other acceptable packaging material to protect all components from damage during shipping
  - REDDI-CRATE® or equivalent needs to be taped shut with a minimum
     100 lbs. / in. tensile strength reinforced filament-shipping tape
    - If a REDDI-CRATE® is used, the ends will need to fastened shut with wood blocks and screws

- Tape is required on each end and every 3 feet thereafter
- Any package over 150 lbs. requires a reinforced dimensional wood (e.g.: 2x4, 2x6, etc.) box designed to be move via fork truck
  - Parts need to braced with wood and screws inside the box to eliminate all movement of the component
- Steel banding strips are required for all packaging over 150 lbs.
  - Install steel banding strips on each end of the package and every 3 feet thereafter
    - (Minimum of 2 steel banding strips per package)
- All wood packaging must use screws to attach the lid to package for ease of removal upon arrival at Reiloy USA
- Multiple parts in the same package need to secured/protected in a manner to ensure parts do not sustain damage during shipping

#### 5. REILOY USA SUPPLIED PACKAGING:

- Components shipped to any facility may use original packaging to pack and ship product back to Reiloy USA
  - All tape, screws, wood bracing, packaging materials and steel bands are to be reinstalled in/on packaging before shipping back to Reiloy USA
    - A Minimum of a 100 lbs./in. tensile strength reinforced filamentshipping tape is to be used and installed in the same locations as when the item was received at your facility
